

**Guidelines to Enrollment as an Official with the
Oklahoma Secondary Schools Activity Association (OSSAA)**

(Note: To officiate sporting events for member schools an official must be enrolled with the OSSAA and have passed the on-line test for the sport.)

Visit the OSSAA website at www.ossaa.com. Click on the *officials* link. Click on the *enrollment form* link.

Return the enrollment form to the OSSAA office with a check/money order.

You will receive a packet for the sport(s) enrolled. Packets are mailed in a timely fashion prior to the beginning of each sport season. Refer to information on the website for mailing dates.

Your official identification number is printed to the left of your name on the mailing label.

As of Fall of 2009 we will no longer issue official identification cards.

All sport testing is done on-line. Information for the on-line testing system is in your packet.

Upon completion of the on-line test(s) you are eligible to officiate in that sport in contests involving OSSAA member schools. An official must score a 75% to pass the on-line test. Two attempts at each test are allowed.

(Your test score is sent automatically to the OSSAA office from the on-line test center.)

Contact the local coordinator for your sport. Phone numbers for local coordinators are in your packet or can be obtained by contacting the OSSAA office—405.840.1116.

State rules meetings are required and are listed in your packet and on the website. Local meetings are required and meeting times and places can be obtained from the local coordinator.

Regular season games are NOT assigned by the OSSAA. Local coordinators can provide information on obtaining game assignments via a sport commissioner or local school district.
