**GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR ALL-STAR CONTESTS**

The Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association shall have jurisdiction in sanctioning all All-Star games held in the State of Oklahoma.

**FOOTBALL** - No All-Star contest will be approved during the school year.

**BASKETBALL AND BASEBALL** - Before the season closes: Area or conference All-Star contests may be approved upon application to the Association office. (All senior high students eligible) - After the season closes: No All-Star contests will be approved until after all state-sponsored activities are complete. Any All-Star contest approved after the season closes will be restricted to graduating seniors only. (NCAA does not limit the number of All-Star games after a student graduates.)

**WRESTLING** - No All-Star contest will be approved during the school year until after all state-sponsored activities are complete.

**OTHER SPORTS** - Area or conference All-Star contests, which are to be held prior to the close of the season, may be approved upon application to the Association office with all students being eligible for participation

1. A student may participate in not more than two All-Star contests in each sport. Exception: Graduated seniors must comply only with the NCAA regulations.
2. Any student may participate in an All-Star contest provided it is held prior to the end of the season in that particular sport. (The season ends with the state championship tournament or meet for that particular sport.)
3. No All-Star contest will be approved during the time from the end of the season in that particular sport until such time as all of the Association sponsored activities are completed (usually in May).
4. Any All-Star contest approved by the OSSAA after the Association sponsored activities are completed shall be limited to graduating seniors only.
