RE: District Soccer Assignments - 2007-08 and 2008-09
DATE: November 7, 2007

Below you will find the District Soccer assignments for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 school years. Boys' and Girls' Soccer teams will participate in three classes of competition. Class 6A soccer will consist of the first 32 soccer playing schools on the 2006-07 ADM sheet. Class 5A soccer will consist of the next 32 soccer playing schools, Class 4A will consist of all remaining soccer playing schools. Teams assigned to a district will play each opponent one district match. In all classes the champion, runner-up, third, and fourth place finisher of each district will advance to the playoff series.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

1. The first school listed in each district will serve as district chairperson. It is the responsibility of the district chairperson to report the district standings to the O.S.S.A.A. no later than 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 23, 2008. E-mail acassell@ossaa.com or call 405-840-1116.
2. Each district chairperson should notify each school in their district of the soccer scheduling meeting. At this meeting schools will schedule district matches and any other matches or tournaments. The scheduling meeting for Districts 1 and 2 in each class will be at **Westmoore High School (Cafeteria Commons), Thursday, November 15, 2007 at 7:00 p.m.** The scheduling meeting for Districts 3 and 4 in each class will be at the **Tulsa Public Schools Education Service Center, Monday, November 19, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.**
3. **All district matches shall be completed by Tuesday, April 22, 2008.**
4. There shall be a maximum of three scrimmage dates with the first scrimmage date to be no earlier than February 14, 2008. The regular season shall open on March 1, 2008. **No team shall be allowed to scrimmage in soccer after March 1. There will be no loss of instructional time for scrimmages or scrimmage tournaments.**
5. Each team is allowed **ten** regular season matches and **one** regular season, eight team maximum bracket tournament. This total shall include all conference and conference play-off matches and all district matches.
6. Any player receiving 3 yellow cards in accordance with the OSSAA Yellow Card Policy must sit out the next contest at the same level of play. Coaches shall report yellow cards to the accumulator. E-mail yellow cards received by your players to john.timmons@jenksps.org or acassell@ossaa.com. Game officials will report all cards issued in a contest to the accumulator. (District chairpersons will be designated by the OSSAA). A violation of this rule may result in a penalty imposed on the coach and/or team by the OSSAA.

Points of emphasis:

1. Cards accumulated prior to March 1 will not carry over into the regular season.
2. Cards accumulated prior to the first playoff game will not carry over into the playoffs UNLESS the 3rd yellow card is issued in the last game played prior to the first playoff game.
