RE: Regional Cheerleading Competition Assignments
DATE: September 2, 2009

Below you will find assignments and other information for the regional cheerleading competition. Please review this material carefully, as there will be no mailing to your school. The regional competition will be held on September 19, 2009. **Floor passes for the regional competition can be picked up at the check in table at your regional site. These are the ONLY passes you will receive, lost or misplaced floor passes will not be replaced.**

Each competition will begin at the assigned times.

NOTE: Fans and squads are not allowed to bring spirit posters, banners, etc. Admission prices are \$5.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students. The OSSAA complimentary play-off pass (orange) will be the only pass accepted.

COACHES: Please remember that we will have a State Finals Program. If you qualify for state and want your squad to appear in the program, you should send your squad's picture, roster and the sponsor sheet to Sid Ahlschlager, 8 NW 59th Street, Lawton, Oklahoma, 73505-5814. If you have any questions concerning the State Finals Program, contact Sid Ahlschlager at (580) 536-2142. His FAX number is (580) 536-2142. Program information sheets are attached below.

NOTE: If you had a stunt reviewed regarding the legality of your squad's routine you must take a copy with you to your regional site.

**** The following is a list of new regulations or points of emphasis:**

1. The area used for competition must be matted.
2. The squad must use a minimum of one and one half minutes of the two minute time limit.
3. The squad will be penalized ten points on each judge's score sheet if every member is not completely off the mat at the end of the two minute limit or if the squad does not meet the one and one half minute minimum time requirement.
4. If the cheer routine is interrupted by an injury to one of the participants the coach may choose to finish the routine from the point of interruption or choose to take the score earned to that point, without any deduction for the minimum time limit not being met.
5. In the event of a tie, all judges' score sheets will be used for the tied squads. If the additional score sheets do not break the tie; the teams will be awarded the appropriate places.
6. See the 2009-2010 OSSAA Cheerleading manual for further information concerning managing a regional tournament.
7. Coaches who have not attended a rules meeting need to contact the OSSAA office to obtain a cheer rules test to be taken prior to regional competition.
8. The performance order for the squads competing at the Regional and State competition has been set by the OSSAA staff. (NOTE: The order has been randomly selected by the OSSAA staff.) The order of competition is as listed on each regional sheet. An emergency will be the only exception for being late. If an emergency occurs, contact the site manager.

Dear Cheer leading Coach,

OKLAHOMA CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAMS will again be providing programs for the state cheerleading tournament. However, we will need your help to make certain the programs will be something you, your fans, and cheerleaders will be proud of using and keeping as a souvenir.

The cost for putting your squad's picture and roster in the program will be the same as last year- \$150.00 for a half page and \$250.00 for a full page. We are asking you to obtain sponsor(s) for the amount required to print the coverage you desire. Last year all the qualifiers but ten had coverage. In some cases your school may desire to sponsor your squad in the program.

If businesses sponsor your page, your cheerleaders could collect the money and deposit in your school account and we could bill your account, or we will invoice the sponsor(s) after the tournament is complete. We would prefer money be collected and deposited in a school account and the school account be billed. Some businesses are slow to pay and in some cases have not paid. In such cases we will solicit your help in collecting.

Enclosed is a form we will need for you to complete in giving us the information we need. Also, include any ad copy your sponsors or school desire to have in the program.

Some of you and/or your cheerleaders might want to make contacts with potential sponsors before regionals so your work can be completed in time.
