There will be a coaches' meeting for class 2A at 9:00 a.m. in the auditorium. All Class 3A coaches will meet at 10:30 a.m. in the scoring tent.

State awards (only the 7 participants permitted on the awards stand at the assembly)

- 1. Championship and runner-up trophies in each class will be given for team awards. Gold medals will be given to each championship team member, silver medals will be given to second place team members and bronze medals will be given to third place team members. Teams will be given a maximum of 7 medals.
2. Individual awards include gold medals for the first five (5) finishers; silver medals for the five (5) second place finishers; bronze medals for the five (5) third place finishers.

The State course will be open at 12:00 noon the day before competition and close at 12:00 noon the day of competition.

Admission is \$5.00 for adults and students.
